Among my favourites from this village in this cellar. Opens with ripe, plummy fruit and hints of earth and smoke. The texture has firm tannin, impressive substance and a depth that leads to a lingering finish. The grapes are from this southeast-facing climat at the base of Corton Perrières. This should open fairly early and is perfectly suited to mid-term ageing.

Le Pré de Manche is an interesting terroir on the border with Monthélie near premier cru Les Cras. The grapes sourced there have produced an elegant, citrusy Meursault with a medium body and a lively, invigorating freshness. The grapes are gently pressed and fermented in used casks where they will age 12-15 months. This wine will be ready to drink on release and equally suited to mid-term ageing.

The Corton Perrières from Parcelles de Saulx is a kinder, gentler version of Corton. There is substance and structure, but also an expressive plummy fruit with hints of spice. Notably absent are the astringent tannins one can find in the Perrières climat. The wine is aged exclusively in used casks to preserve the purity of the fruit; it should open in three to five years and will easily drink over the next 20.
