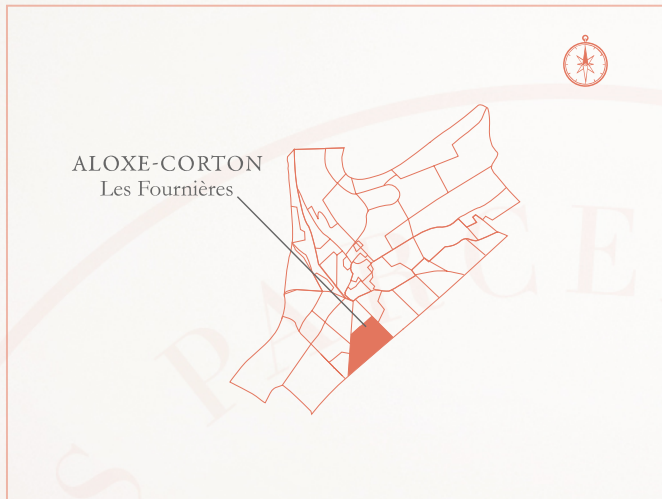
RICH AND WELL BALANCED

THIS "CLIMAT"

The name "Fournières" comes from the practice used to clear this parcel by a burn-out process consisting in burning the remains of clearing by building stoves with dried clods of earth called Fournières.

TERROIR

Facing to the east, under the Corton "les Perrières", the soil is clayey and deep.



TASTING

Appearance : Beautiful dark ruby color.

Bouquet : Expressive nose with aromas of red fruits and liquorice.

In the mouth : Rich with aromas of red fruits. A beautiful intensity and pleasant tannins with a well balanced oak.
