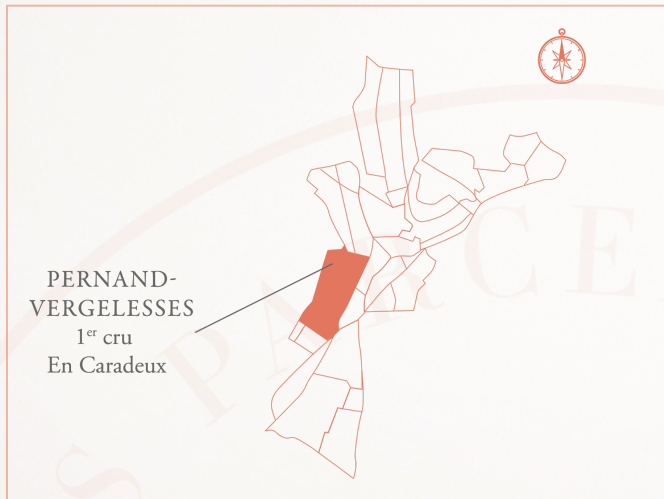

Facing to the east on a sloping hillside, the soil is shallow and very stony.

Appearance : Clear and shiny
